On the 14th September, a "Get Raucus against AUKUS" protest was held at the reserve next to the Osborne Community Centre. This is just a kilometre from the Osborne Naval Shipyard where the SSN AUKUS nuclear submarines will be built by BAE.

Port Adelaide Community opposes AUKUS PACOA) organised 9 speakers from a range of groups affected by and in opposition to AUKUS. Eileen Darley spoke on behalf of PACOA; Vivian McKenzie, a Kurna Elder; Mike Khizam spoke for Australian Friends of Palestine Association; Tony Bazely from Port Adelaide Environment Protection Group; Jordan Shane from Australian Voice; Diana Tate from PACOA; Sue Herbet from the Women's International League for Peace and Freedom (WILF); Hayden Shaw from the Greens and PACOA and Campbell Duignan.

Resolutions passed Sunday 21 September, 2025, UN International Day of Peace



Resolution 1: On AUKUS

Today is the International Day of Peace. It is therefore appropriate that we, the people of Naarm-Melbourne attending this public forum at the Victorian Trades Hall, move the following resolution:

We demand that the AUKUS military Agreement with the USA and Britain be cancelled:

- (i) At a cost of over \$368 billion - or \$35 million a day, every day, for the next thirty years – this aggressive military pact takes public funding away from people's needs and does not serve the best interests of the population of Australia.
We demand that the \$368 billion of people's taxes is spent on affordable housing for all, schools, hospitals, social and community needs of the people, manufacturing industries and combatting climate crisis.
- (ii) We oppose Australia being turned into a US military base and launching pad for a US-led war on China, making us a military target. We call for dismantling Pine Gap and all US bases on Australian soil.

Israel says more than 400 people detained from Gaza aid flotilla, will start deportations

The Israeli navy has intercepted vessel after vessel at sea since Thursday, after warning the activists against entering waters it says fall under its blockade, with Thunberg's boat among those stopped from going further.

An Israeli official said more than 400 activists aboard 41 vessels were detained during the operation

Sydney Town Hall protest against Israeli interception of flotilla

In response to the interception, hundreds took to the streets of Sydney's CBD overnight for a snap protest in support of those on the Sumud Flotilla.

The event, organised by members of the Palestine Action Group, was held after the Israeli navy intercepted the widely publicised Gaza-bound flotilla, which included dozens of boats holding activists including Greta Thunberg.

Police say an estimated 400 people attended the unauthorised march through the CBD before they returned to Sydney's Town Hall.

Israel is committing genocide in Gaza, major United Nations report finds

Israel has committed and is continuing to commit genocide in Gaza, according to the "most authoritative assessment" to date.

A United Nations Commission of Inquiry (CoI), established by the UN Human Rights Council, concluded that Israeli authorities "intended to kill as many Palestinians as possible" and have committed the crime against humanity of extermination.

The report cites direct targeting of civilians, including children, and

mass killings in "far larger numbers compared to previous conflicts".

It also found Israel deliberately inflicted life-threatening conditions by blocking food, water and medicine — actions "calculated" to bring about the "destruction of Palestinians".

The inquiry's report follows a two-year investigation and builds on a growing number of assessments labelling Israel's actions as genocide.

SECRET CARGO: INSIDE AUSTRALIA'S COVERT F-35 PARTS PIPELINE TO ISRAEL

At least 68 shipments of F-35 fighter jet parts have been flown on commercial passenger planes to Israel from Australia as recently as last month, leaked documents reveal.

This Declassified Australia investigation is published in partnership with investigative news site, [The Ditch](#).

Detailed shipping records seen by *Declassified Australia* show the most recent shipment of F-35 fighter jet parts to Israel left Sydney two weeks ago destined to Tel Aviv, exported in the cargo bay of a scheduled passenger flight from Sydney International Airport.

Declassified Australia has examined the details of confidential shipping records listing a total of 68 shipments of F-35 Joint Strike Fighter aircraft parts flown from Australia directly to Israel between October 2023 and September 2025. The multiple F-35 parts and components being sent to Israel are bypassing the two main centralised distribution hubs for F-35 parts in the US and Netherlands by being sent as cargo on commercial passenger flights from Australia to Israel.

Kellie Tranter: 'Australia is breaching its international obligations on weapons to Israel'

The International and Peaceful Network Australia (IPAN) has initiated an open letter calling on defence minister Richard Marles to stop sending weapons and parts to Israel. Sign [HERE](#)

The letter states that Australia has been continuing military exports to Israel as it commits mass murder in the Gaza Strip, including supplying the [devices that open weapons bay doors for F-35 fighter jets](#) and the [Electro Optic Systems R400 cannon](#).

It also calls on Labor to cancel the \$917 million defence contract with Israeli weapons corporation Elbit Systems.

It further warns that, under current arrangements, Australia and government ministers involved in the lethal trade are complicit in supporting and aiding Israel's mass slaughter and starvation program in Gaza. Having ratified the [1948 Genocide Convention](#) in 1949, Australia is required to prevent and punish a genocide, in times of peace or war, under its first article.

Calls are mounting for the UN General Assembly to bypass Security Council vetoes and urgently deploy a protection force to halt the Gaza genocide and deliver peace, writes Bevan Ramsden.

A business case to establish a nuclear submarine base at Port Kembla or Newcastle is being prepared for the NSW Cabinet, but the public is being kept totally in the dark. Transparency Warrior Rex Patrick reports.

It's a radioactive issue in more ways than one, with no one in either the Federal or NSW government prepared to talk about it with the people they govern.

Discussions between the two parties are clearly well advanced, with a final NSW Cabinet submission in preparation – a fact that has been kept secret until the Department of Planning, Housing and Infrastructure inadvertently revealed it in NSW Civil and Administrative Tribunal (NCAT) proceedings.


The move came after a recent telephone call by Trump to PM Anthony Albanese and other pressures and demands by US officials for Australia to radically increase military spending.

Storage and maintenance of USMC MV-22 Osprey aircraft in Australia

The Australian Government has approved the storage and maintenance of United States Marine Corps (USMC) MV-22 Osprey Aircraft in Australia.

Brigadier Mick Say, Director-General Force Posture Initiatives Branch, said the maintenance and repositioning of the MV-22s in Australia will advance force posture cooperation with the US.

“For more than a decade, cooperation between Australia and the US, under the Force Posture Agreement, has enhanced our capacity to deter coercion and maintain a secure and stable Indo-Pacific,” Brigadier Say said.

“The storage of MV-22 Ospreys in Australia, between annual MRF-D rotations is consistent with the US Force Posture Agreement, and represents the continuing development of a deeper relationship with the United States.”

Australian sovereignty and the path to peace

EXTRACT

"Labor should:

- Publicly declare that it is not in Australia's interest to engage in a war with China over Taiwan.
- Take urgent steps to identify alternatives to AUKUS and the Force Posture Agreement.
- Give notice to the United States and United Kingdom of our intention to end AUKUS and the Force Posture Agreement.
- Ensure we have genuine parliamentary oversight of defence and the security and intelligence services, and given the Parliamentary Joint Committee on Intelligence and Security (PJCIS) is toothless has no capacity for oversight of its activities, as in comparable democracies, PJCIS powers must be urgently and significantly enhanced.
- Legislate for a parliamentary debate and determination prior to any declaration to have our military engage in conflict.
- Establish and fund a National Peace Research Institute to operate in parallel with the Diplomatic Academy at the Department of Foreign Affairs and the National Security College at the ANU.
- While we're at it, we should change the title of the ludicrously named Australian War College in the Department of Defence back to the Australian Defence College.
- Conduct a parliamentary inquiry into the implications of the revolving door of former parliamentarians, advisers, public servants and military personnel being employed by companies and institutions funded by or part of the global military-industrial complex. Come to think of it, we should apply this to the mining industry as well.
- Legislate to proscribe former parliamentarians, advisers, public servants and military personnel from being employed by arms

manufacturers for a period of five years after they have left the Commonwealth payroll.

- Take steps to increase the density and complexity of our research, science and manufacturing sector with a view to improving our defence capacities and widening our industrial base.
- Reduce our dependence on US military equipment and technology.
- Increase political and diplomatic engagement with Asia-Pacific nations, particularly China.
- Require the ABC to ensure commentators on defence issues divulge any conflict of interest, funding from or employment within the military industrial complex. Any such conflicts would be announced prior to appearances on ABC news or current affairs programs.

In conclusion, and in the Carmichael tradition, I call on Labor parliamentarians, the trade union movement rank-and-file activists and the public to educate themselves about the madness that is AUKUS, organise against militarism and build a campaign in support of peace, diplomacy and common sense.



