- IPAN calls on the Prime Minister and Foreign Minister to condemn recent illegal Israeli attacks on the Sumud Flotilla and condemn the ongoing Israeli genocide against Palestinians.
- Australia is failing in its obligations under international law by not condemning the actions of Israel.
- Australia is complicit in Israeli genocide through contracts with Israeli companies and the role of Pine Gap.

The Independent and Peaceful Australia Network (IPAN) is extremely disappointed in Foreign Minister Wong's response to the most recent Israeli attacks on the Sumud Flotilla and the abduction of people, including Australians, on the boats. According to Zack Schofield, one of six Australians detained by the Israelis, fellow activists were violently

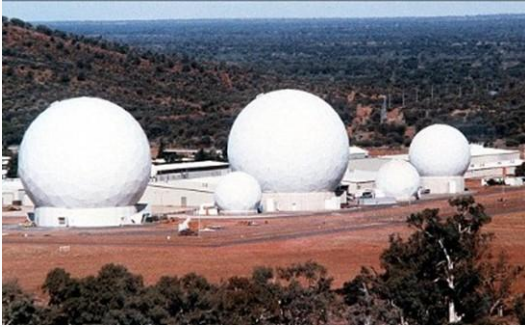
We see every day the latest horrors of full scale war. Whether in Gaza, Lebanon or Iran, thousands of people are being murdered by the military machines of the US and Israel. At the same time almost unbelievable environmental destruction is caused.

We in Australia are deeply involved - Pine gap base sends target information, Kojarena base sends secure field mobile phone signals between US soldiers, NW Cape base send signals to US attack submarines (with Australian sailors on board) sailing from Sterling naval base. Worldwide military activities add more than one twentieth of the total greenhouse gases in our atmosphere each year, a large proportion of it coming from the US military.

In this film a US foreign policy reporter and her Iraq veteran husband turn their sights on the hidden impact the US military has on the planet, after the birth of their first child creates anxiety about the climate crisis. Their investigation exposes a secretive and constantly-expanding web of pollution, cover-ups and unaccountability by the world's biggest polluter.

Spain closes US access to its joint bases with US to avoid complicity in Illegal US war on Iran

Spain has closed to the US the use of its Naval base at Rota and its air-force base at Moron; both are Joint Bases with the US and has closed Spanish airspace for use by the US in its war on Iran saying that the war is a flagrant violation of international law and that Spain will have no part in it.

This, despite threats including economic ones and political pressure from the US. Spain has taken a sovereign independent state decision and shown that a NATO country can say no.

BAE Systems in South Australia targeted by Anti-War Protestors

In the early hours of Wednesday 8th April, anti-war activists blocked the entrance to the BAE Systems building at Edinburgh, north of Adelaide/Tarntanya, to protest the company's manufacture and supply of titanium parts for the F-35 bomber jets used by the Israeli and US militaries. The Edinburgh precinct is one of five locations owned by the global company in Adelaide.

The protestors chained the entrance gates shut, and one activist chained themselves to the gates, remaining locked on for three hours to send a clear message that providing parts to the US-Israeli war machine makes Australia complicit in genocide and needless military aggression in the Middle East.

Australian says flotilla crews bashed by Israeli troops

An Australian member of a Gaza aid flotilla has described how fellow activists were shot with rubber bullets, hit with rifle butts and bashed after Israeli soldiers boarded their boats.

Zack Schofield was one of six Australians detained by the Israeli military while attempting to transport aid to Gaza.

They were among 175 flotilla participants detained on Wednesday by the Israeli Defence Force out of nearly 700 heading across the Mediterranean. Speaking to AAP from the Greek island of Crete on Saturday he said some people were shot at point-blank range with rubber bullets as soldiers boarded their boats in international waters. "Some of us were kicked and punched as we were being processed on our own boats, many of which were sunk," Mr Schofield said.

Australia's sovereignty is routinely violated by Israel. Our institutions utterly subject to foreign interference. **Andrew Brown** presents the

devastating case for a royal commission into Zionist influence in Australia.

Yesterday we laid out the machinery of the most serious foreign influence operation ever conducted on Australian soil: the quasi-diplomatic network operating from inside Australian institutions, the 500-plus politicians and journalists conditioned in Tel Aviv at a foreign government's expense, the foreign minister instructed by a donor network to recant established international law, the attorney-general who adopted Israeli legal talking points as official Australian government language, the \$164 million in security infrastructure extracted from Australian taxpayers for a community of 120,000 people, and the government-appointed envoy drawn from the lobby itself whose job is to put Israeli government policy beyond the reach of Australian public criticism.

Today we examine the enforcement arm. What this operation does to individuals, institutions, and the fundamental democratic rights of ordinary Australians who exercise their right to disagree. And what it did, for more than a decade, with Australian sovereignty itself.



“The blatant aggression that the United State so often adopts to
achieve its aims of dominance are laid out in plain English in the

recently released [United States National Security Strategy \(NSS\)](#) document.

This is a startling and dangerous outline of that country's 'America First', isolationist, race-based approach that is a significant shift in Washington's past approaches. Here the Western World has shifted to the Western Hemisphere, first defined in the Monroe Doctrine of 1823 to mean the Americas, and then updated by Trump to mean anywhere it wants to influence or control, it seems.

This new world view set out in the NSS seeks to abandon multi-lateral organisations that have strived to maintain global peace since the Second World War and to enact a goal 'summarized as Enlist and Expand' (p.16). The actions of institutions, such as the United Nations, are described as 'sovereignty sapping incursions of intrusive transnational organizations' (p.9), and there is no commitment to the international rules-based order that our Australian government claims to support. "

"Prime Minister Albanese immediately, the first world leader to do so, supported not only the Israeli and US war of aggression, but did so based on a lie.

“Unconstitutional”. Court strikes down Minns’ draconian anti-protest laws

The Supreme Court of New South Wales has struck down the state’s draconian anti-protest laws, ruling they impose an impermissible burden on political communication and are invalid. **Stephanie Tran** reports.

In a [landmark decision](#) on Thursday, the court declared key provisions of the anti-protest laws introduced after the Bondi terrorist attack unconstitutional, finding they gave police sweeping powers to shut down protests across large parts of Sydney without sufficient justification.

“The impugned provisions infringe the implied freedom of political communication,” the court found.

More than 20 people have been arrested at protests in Brisbane over the weekend, with pro-Palestine groups calling on the Crisafulli government to repeal its contentious hate-speech laws.

A strong police presence blanketed Brisbane's CBD, including plain-clothed officers and riot police, as hundreds of protesters marched on Parliament on Sunday afternoon.

The Crisafulli government passed laws outlawing two phrases commonly used by pro-Palestinian protesters – “from the river to the sea” and “globalise the intifada” – when used to incite hostility towards a group or when reasonably expected to offend the public.

Justice for Palestine Magan-djin's Remah Naji described the laws as “asburd” and “dangerous”, telling the group gathered that they were co-ordinating a high court challenge on the basis that the laws were “invalid” under the Australian constitution.

“I think anyone with a brain can see the disparity between, on the one hand, the actual crimes carried out by apartheid Israel... and on the other hand, the passing of laws that criminalise words.”

After witnessing Parliament's shockingly authoritarian overreach in January in forcing through a law in just 24 hours that can ban groups and jail members, retrospectively and even without a crime being committed, the Citizens Party has today launched a petition to stop an equally authoritarian bill from the Albanese government that makes Australia a permanent police state.

The bill is the Australian Security Intelligence Organisation Amendment Bill (No. 2) 2025, which expands the interrogation powers that turned ASIO into Australia's secret police in 2003, and repeals the sunset clause to make those powers permanent.

These are powers that caused political consternation in 2002-03, and provoked Labor Opposition Leader Simon Crean to accuse Prime Minister John Howard of establishing a "police state".

Petition Summary

We therefore ask the House to:

1. **Reject the Australian Security Intelligence Organisation Amendment Bill (No. 2) 2025; and**
2. **Repeal all of ASIO's secret police powers enacted since 2003 and return to the principle of civilian policing under independent judicial oversight.**

Antidotes for pepper spray

The best antidotes for pepper spray include rinsing with water, using dairy products like milk, and applying baking soda or commercial decontamination products.

Effective Remedies for Pepper Spray Exposure

1. **Rinse with Water:** Start by flushing the affected area with cool, clean water. This helps to dilute the capsaicin, the active ingredient in pepper spray, but may not be sufficient on its own due to the oil-based nature of capsaicin.
2. **Use Dairy Products:** Dairy products, particularly whole milk or yogurt, can effectively neutralize the burning sensation. Capsaicin is oil-based, and dairy helps to break down the oils. You can apply milk directly to the skin or soak a cloth in it and place it on the affected area.
3. **Baking Soda Paste:** Mixing baking soda with water to create a paste can help neutralize the acidity caused by pepper spray. Apply the paste to the affected skin for a few minutes before rinsing it off.

Opening a new level of federal authoritarianism, a new Federal Police unit has been created to intimidate and deter demonstrators protesting against AUKUS.

The **AUKUS AFP Command** has been established under the Australian Federal Police (AFP), in conjunction with the Department of Defence. The **AUKUS AFP Command's** powers cover the security of AUKUS operations, extending to wider US military activity elsewhere. Its activities are of considerable concern since among its roles is "Public Order Management" listing of "munitions" which include tear gas, pepper spray, rubber bullets and real firearms.

Since 2003 and 9/11 a raft of laws have been passed by successive Australian governments attacking our civil and democratic rights, including freedom of speech and political protest. Some of these laws have been used against the environment movement.

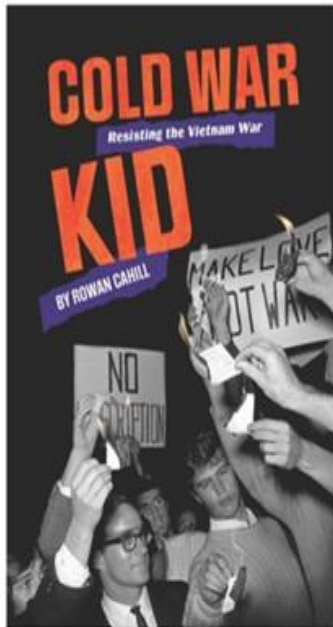

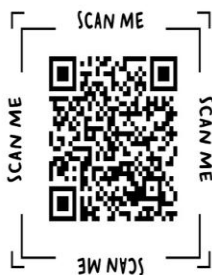
